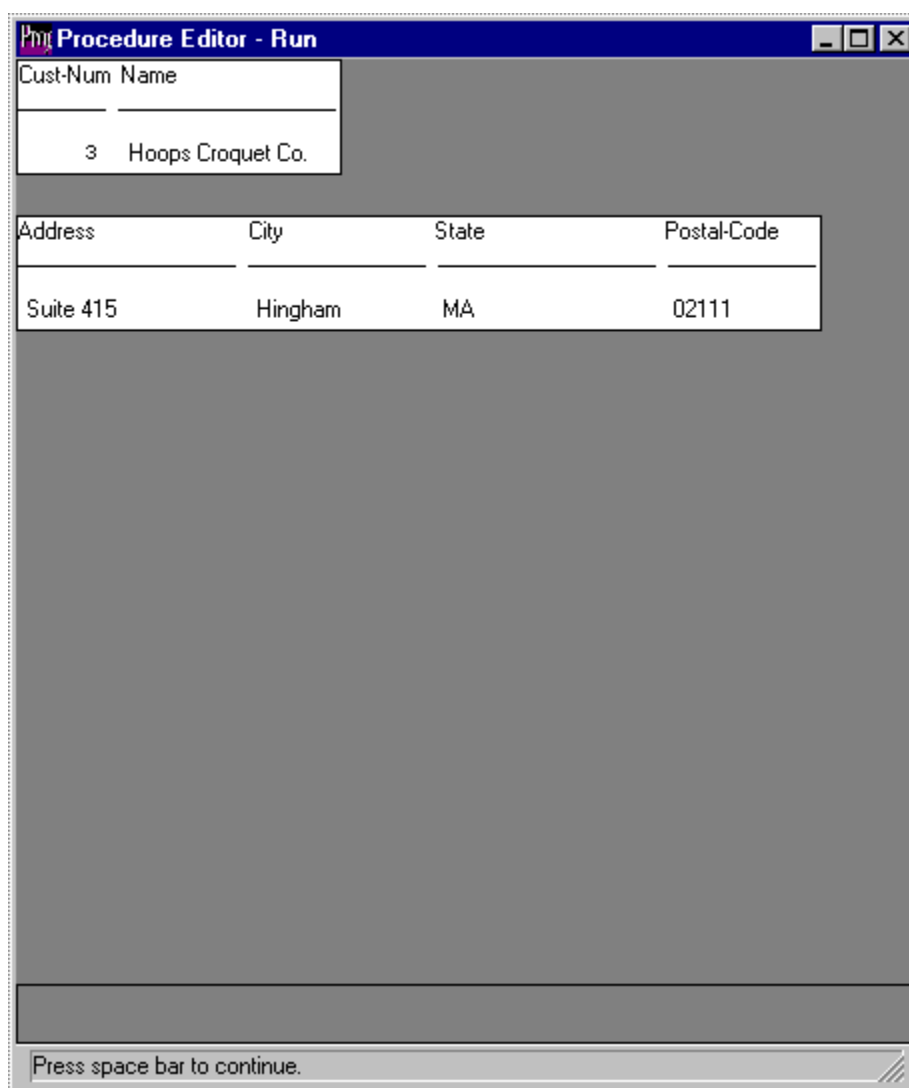


## What's in a Frame Name?

/* b-frame3.p */  
  
for each customer:  
    display cust-num name with frame a.  
    display address city state postal-code with frame b.  
end. /* for each customer */
```



## What's in a Frame Name?

- To name a frame, use the **WITH FRAME *frame-name*** syntax in the frame phrase.
- Generally, use the default, unnamed frame supplied with each block.
- You should only need to name frames in two situations:
  - ◆ Using more than one frame in the same block.
  - ◆ Referring to the same frame in two different blocks.
- You should put all frame phrase characteristics on the block header statement.
  - ◆ This makes coding easier and eliminates the need to specify the frame name and other frame characteristics on each **PROGRESS** statement within the block for that default frame.
